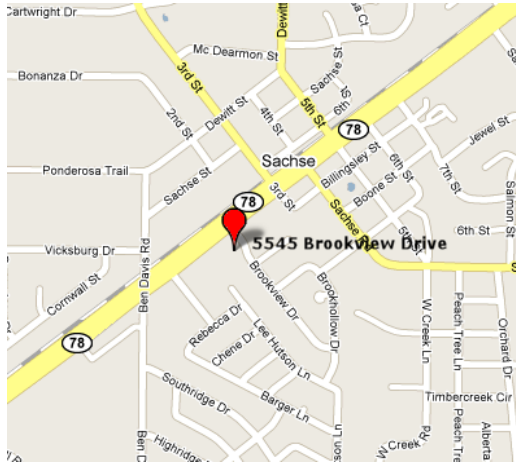

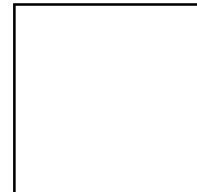

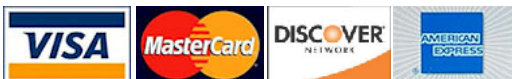

## Our Curriculum

Toddlers are nurtured and cared for in a safe, stimulating environment. They are involved in daily structured activities that emphasize language development, self care, socialization, physical development, and exploration.

In a play environment, preschool children interact to develop skills and learn concepts. Through stories, drama, music, art, and learning centers the children make discoveries, learning to become aware of self and others and to communicate about their world.

Pre-Kindergarten 4 year old and young 5 year old students interact in small groups and in learning centers. Numbers and letters are introduced through use of "big books", rhymes, and games. "Real life" experiences (cooking, sewing, housekeeping, record-keeping, etc.) provide opportunities for developing reading and math skills.

Our infants are provided for in a warm, loving setting with knowledgeable caregivers. They are nurtured in a stimulating environment where they are allowed to learn and grow at their own pace.

Schoolers are provided an encouraging environment for homework, social development, arts and crafts, and center activities. Fun and educational field trips and a great summer program are also provided.

Tammy Small with Small Bytes for Kids provides classes for our 3-4 year olds to help them learn and improve their computer skills. Age-specific curriculum encourages and captivates these
